Thanks to all who came to our recent meeting, it was lovely to see some new faces and great to have returning members. We discussed fund raising ideas, we will be continuing with the usual annual fund raising events and hopefully introducing some new ones, details of which will follow shortly.

Our first fund raising event of the year will be a **Wine Tasting Night on Thursday 29th September 7.30-10pm**. Tickets are on sale currently every morning and after school at the notice board outside school. It is aimed to be a fun filled night with some brief information from Chris Taylor on a selection of wines, all of which you will get to taste. There will be a fun wine themed quiz and a raffle with prizes. Tickets are £10 each which includes the wine and cheese. Please come along and have fun relaxing with friends whilst raising funds for school.

Our 2nd fund raising event this year will be the annual **Sponsored Walk on Friday 30th September**. All pupils can participate and will set off at 2.15p.m, with the aim of walking laps of the school field. Parents, grandparents and carers are invited to join us walking or can offer moral support from the side lines. Pupils should remember their water bottles to keep hydrated. Children should wear their school PE kit with tracksuits, jumpers and coats if needed. Reception children need only bring a change of shoes/boots, depending on the weather. The sponsored walk is a great opportunity for our children to raise money by collecting sponsors (please see form attached and return monies to school). Let's hope that this year's walk will be a successful occasion.
