## Christmas Fair – Friday 1st December 2017 1.30 pm

As you already know, on Friday 1st December 2017 the Home and School Association will be holding their Christmas Fair. There will be the usual stalls and games and a chance to buy a gift for a friend or loved one. The fair is always a great fun event for our parents, family members, and friends to enjoy with their child. Entry to the fair is through the main school entrance.

### Pupils in Key stage 2

Pupils in Key stage 2 may bring money to school and visit the stalls independently from 1.30pm. On no account must pupils leave the building without their adult to sign them out at the school office.

### Pupils in Reception and Key Stage 1

Parents may collect their children from 1.30pm once they have entered the fair through the main school entrance. If you know that you will be arriving later than 1.30pm, please let your child's class teacher know your approximate time of arrival. Parents arriving later will find Reception and KS1 pupils in the Class 2 classroom. If you cannot attend the fair with your child please send them a little money to spend.

### Pupil Safety

Whilst the afternoon is relaxed, it is still important that our pupils are safe. As is usual practice parents may take pupils home after visiting the fair and signing out at the school office. However pupils in Key Stage 2 who normally walk home alone must not leave the school premises before 3.15pm under any circumstances. Pupils will not be allowed to leave early with an adult who is not the person who usually collects them at the end of the school day unless school has **written confirmation**. Please do not ask your child to pass on verbal messages to school.

### Donations

Thank you to those who have already sent in donations of items for the fair.

Those who still have items that they wish to donate (cakes etc.) to the fair should send them to school on Friday morning.
